

Warehousing & Storage Level 2

The Level 2 Certificate in Warehousing and Storage provides an up-to-date qualification that is in line with industry needs and presents an opportunity for individuals to progress to other qualifications.

The qualifications consist of units, each of which has a credit value. In order to achieve the qualification at a particular level, learners must achieve units whose total credit value equals or exceeds that required for that level.

Certificate in Warehousing & Storage Level 2

To achieve a Level 2 Certificate the candidate must complete units to gain a minimum of 26 credits. The credit total is made up from:

- 7 credits must be completed from mandatory units
- A minimum of 19 credits must be completed from optional units

Intermediate Apprenticeship Level 2 – Certificate in Warehousing & Storage (NVQ)

To achieve the Level 2 Certificate in Warehousing & Storage the candidate will need to complete units to gain a minimum of 26 credits. The credit total is made up from:

- 7 credits must be completed from mandatory units
- A minimum of 19 credits must be completed from optional units
